Ten Wines to Love in February

- 2007 Axis Chardonnay** **\$11.99**
Explosive tropical fruit flavors and balanced crispness with a hint of vanilla.
- 2007 Ravenswood Vintners Blend Zinfandel** **\$10.99**
A rich soft zin with flavors of black cherries, mint and vanilla.
- 2007 Sierra Cantabria Rioja** **\$11.99**
A blend of Tempranillo and Graciano grapes. Ripe cherries, oak, raspberries, roses and violets.
- NV Pacific Rim Dry Riesling** **\$7.99**
The wine is crisp, dry and lush with citrus, jasmine and mineral notes. Great with spicy foods!
- 2008 Muga Bianco** **\$13.99**
Creamy in texture, with deep orchard fruit, melon and a hint of dusty minerals.
- 2008 Drylands Sauvignon Blanc** **\$16.99**
Tight, tart and focused, with peach-accented lime and grapefruit flavors that hover enticingly over the crisp finish.
- NV Laetitia Sparkling Brut** **\$22.99**
Citrus, green apple, a touch of black cherry, and soft melon round out the palate. Enjoy this sparkling wine for Valentine's Day; you won't regret it!
- 2005 Chateau le Galion** **\$11.99**
A ripe and fruity medium-bodied red blended exclusively with hand-picked grapes. 60% Merlot, 20% Malbec and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Fess Parker Lot 91 Frontier Red** **\$9.99**
A California-styled Cotes du Rhone, with notes of pepper, black cherries, spice box, roasted herbs and smoke.
- 2007 Casa Setaro Don Vincenzo** **\$11.99**
85% Piediroso and 15% Aglianico
The style is quite contemporary, with bright, tangy tart cherry and raspberry fruit, medium body, and racy acidity. It's juicy and moderately tannic.
